

ORIENTATION CLOCKS

A range of highly visible, easy to read clocks aimed to assist people with dementia and those with cognitive impairment. Memory loss is often the first symptom to appear in someone suffering from dementia or other cognitive impairment. The use of orientation clocks may assist with this problem. These clocks are suited to people with varying degrees of cognitive impairment with the need to be reminded of the day, time or date.
