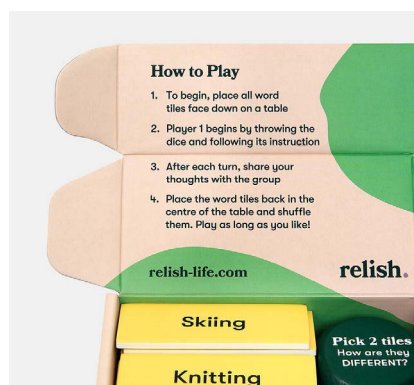

Designed and researched alongside people with dementia, this product features high colour contrast on a large lightweight board to aid people with visual impairments and dexterity difficulties.

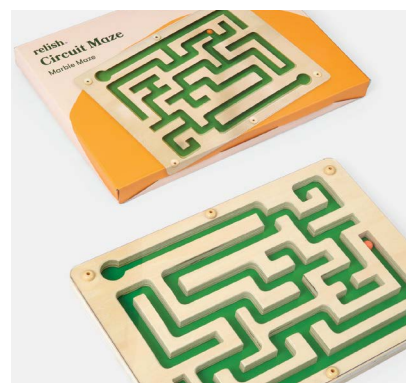


Puzzles

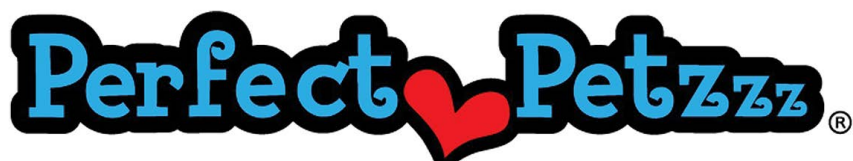
Snap

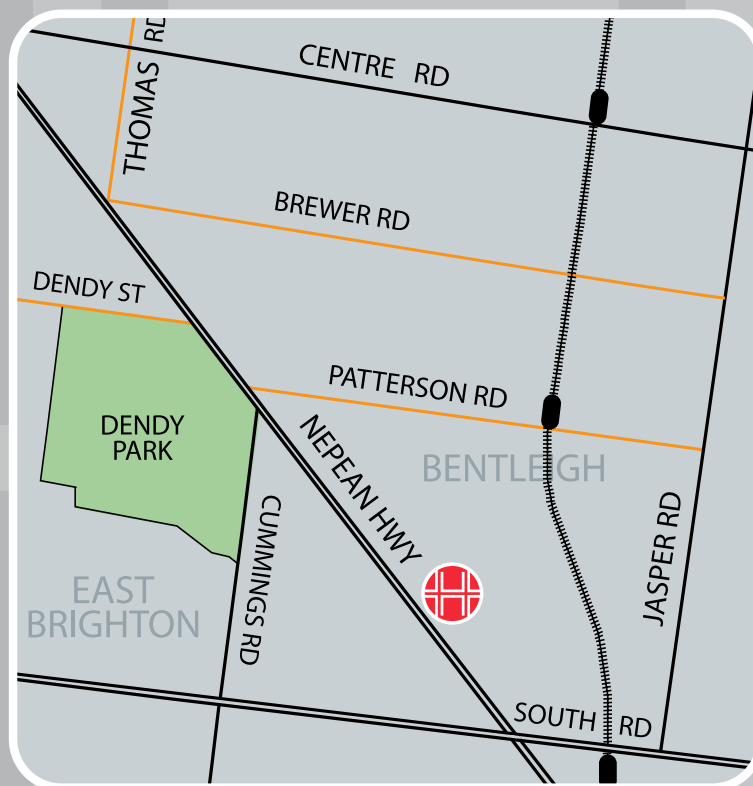
