Joint Replacement Patients Equipment Guide

Independent Living and Rehabilitation Equipment

This information is a general guide to your possible equipment needs post operatively.

Safely Mobilising

It is a good idea to purchase FORE ARM CRUTCHES early to practice prior to your admission.

As fore arm crutches will in most cases be needed for your entire rehabilitation period, it is more cost effective to purchase them, than hire them.





In addition to crutches, different appliances may be needed as your mobility improves post operatively. For example, you may need a WALKING FRAME for a couple of weeks on your arrival home.

A KITCHEN TROLLEY (right) is ideal for use around the house at meal times.



The KITCHEN STOOL (left) is an ideal "energy saver" for use in the kitchen where the user has difficulty standing.



The most important attribute of all these chairs is that they are height adjustable. Rising is simple and your new joint remains at the correct angle as receommended by your surgeon.

The KINGSTON CHAIR (right) is a very basic chair, offering minimal support and height adjustment for easy launching.

For extra comfort, the KAUFMAN, PANAMA and PRESIDENT are all available.

The KAUFMAN (above left) and PANAMA (above right) are mid back chairs which give excellent lower back support. These two chairs are light enough to be moved between rooms if required.

The PRESIDENT is similar to the high back chair you will find in your room on the ward. The high back chair is quite heavy and should be left in one position perhaps near the television.

Patients sometimes hire a high back chair for the lounge room, and use the Kingston or mid back chairs in the dining room or the bedroom in the evening for changing.

All chairs are available for hire or purchase.

Toileting

An OVER TOILET SEAT will add necessary height to your toilet which is important post operatively. The hire time frame on this key appliance is often up to 6 weeks.

The over toilet seat is available for hire or purchase.

An OVER TOILET SEAT allows you to rise easily from the toilet by providing height and supportive arms from which you can launch yourself.



A SAVANAH RAISED TOILET SEATis available when an Over Toilet Seat will not fit. (For example, the vanity unit is too close to the toilet to accomodate

the dimensions of the OVER THE TOILET SEAT.

Bathing

If you have a shower over a bathtub. BATH BOARDS are available to hire.

BATH BOARDS are plastic (depicted) and lock onto the inside of the bathtub to hold them securely in place.

HAND HELD SHOWERS are also an option if a fixed shower screen restricts the boards positioning.




The TRANSFER BENCH is helpful for transferring in and out of the bath if your bath has no ledges to lean a bath board.



For patients who are unable to put weight on their operated leg, SHOWER STOOLS and SHOWER CHAIRS are also available.

If you have a small shower recess, a stool is more compact. SHOWER CHAIRS allow you to sit back in safety and comfort.
